About your SoundTouch[™] wireless adapter

The SoundTouch[™] wireless adapter connects your entertainment system to your home Wi-Fi network so you can enable SoundTouch[™] on your system.

Set up requirements:

- SoundTouch[™] app
- iOS or Android device*
- Broadband Internet connection
- Wireless network (802.11b/g compatible)
- Network name and password
- CineMate® 120, 130, 220 or 520 home theater system

* If you do not have an iOS or Android device, you can use a computer for setup (see page 17).

Connecting the SoundTouch[™] wireless adapter

1. Connect the adapter to the **Bose[®] link** connector on the console.



Note: Place the adapter 1 - 6 ft. (.3 - 1.8 m) away from the Acoustimass[®] module to avoid wireless interference.

2. Set up your CineMate[®] 120, 130, 220, or 520 system (refer to your system's owner's guide).

Adding the system to your Wi-Fi[®] network

You must download and install the SoundTouch[™] app onto a smartphone or tablet that is connected to your network. The app guides you through connecting the system to your network.

Note: If you do not have a smartphone or tablet, you can use a computer for setup (see page 17).

Add the system to an existing SoundTouch[™] account

If you have already set up SoundTouch[™] for another system, you do not need to download the SoundTouch[™] app again.

- 1. On your smartphone or tablet, select 🛐 to launch the app.
- Select EXPLORE > SETTINGS > Systems > ADD SYSTEM to add another system.

The app guides you through setup.

Download and install the SoundTouch[™] app

If this is your first time setting up a SoundTouch[™] system, you must install the app. On your smartphone or tablet, download the **SoundTouch[™] controller app**.



- iOS users: download from the App Store
- Android[™] users: download from the Google Play[™] store

Connect the system to your home Wi-Fi® network

After you install the app, add the system to your network:

- On your smartphone or tablet, select to launch the app.
 The app guides you through connecting the system to your Wi-Fi[®] network.
- Follow the instructions in the app to complete setup, including creating a SoundTouch[™] account, adding a music library and music services.

Accessing SoundTouch™

After you have created a SoundTouch[™] account and set up the adapter, you are ready to enjoy SoundTouch[™] on your system.

- SoundTouch[™] source: Offers a subset of SoundTouch[™] features that enable you to control playback and personalize Presets.
- SoundTouch[™] app: Offers full control of SoundTouch[™], allowing you to manage your SoundTouch[™] settings, add music services, explore local and global Internet radio stations, set and change Presets, stream music to the system, view what is playing, plus much more.

Using the SoundTouch[™] source

Using the remote control, you can access a subset of SoundTouch[™] features through the SoundTouch[™] source.

Press **∑** on your remote to start SoundTouch[™].

Using the SoundTouch[™] app

The SoundTouch[™] app is a software application that enables you to set up and control SoundTouch[™] from your smartphone, tablet, or computer. Using the app, your smart device acts as a rich remote for the SoundTouch[™] source.

The app enables you to manage your SoundTouch[™] settings, add music services, explore local and global Internet radio stations, set and change Presets, stream music to the system, view what is playing, plus much more.

After you set up the system on your network using the SoundTouch[™] app, you are ready to explore streaming music and personalize your Presets.

Getting help

If you need more information on using the system, use Help Tips or In app help.

Help Tips

After setup is complete helpful tips appear on the screen, based on the task you are trying to complete. These tips instruct you how to use the system, including how to personalize your Presets.

To activate the tips

If you have deactivated tips, follow these instructions to re-activate tips.

- 1. Launch the SoundTouch[™] app and select **EXPLORE > SETTINGS >** Help Tips.
- 2. Slide the SHOW TIPS slider to ON.

Controlling the system from another smartphone, tablet, or computer

Once you set up the SoundTouch[™] system on your home Wi-Fi[®] network, you can control the system from any smartphone, tablet, or computer on the same network.

- 1. Connect the device to the same network as your system.
- 2. On the device, download and install the SoundTouch[™] app:

How Presets work

You can personalize six Presets to your favorite streaming music services, stations, playlists, artists, albums, or songs from your music library. You can access your music at any time with a simple touch of a button on the remote control or from the SoundTouch[™] app.

Tip: Access your Presets using the SoundTouch[™] app on your smartphone, tablet, or computer.

What you need to know

- You can set Presets from the app and your universal remote control.
- If the Preset source is your iTunes or Windows Media Player music library, ensure the computer storing your music library is on and connected to the same network as the SoundTouch[™] wireless adapter.

Playing a Preset

Once you personalize your Presets, select a Preset using the remote control or the app to play it. For help refer to the Help system in the SoundTouch[™] app.

Note: If no music plays, see "Setting a Preset".

Setting a Preset

- 1. Stream music to the system using the app.
- 2. While the music is playing, press and hold a number (1 6) on the remote control for about 2 seconds.

The system emits a tone when the preset is set.

Note: For information on using the SoundTouch[™] app, refer to the Help system in the app.

Control Button

The SoundTouch[™] wireless adapter provides advanced functionality through the press and hold of the Control button.



Wi-Fi[®] Indicator

The Wi-Fi® indicator on the back of the adapter indicates Wi-Fi status.

Indicator activity	System state
Blinking white	Connecting to Wi-Fi network
Solid white	System on and connected to Wi-Fi network
Solid amber	System in setup mode
Blinking slow amber	Disconnected from Wi-Fi network
Blinking fast amber	Firmware error - call Bose service
Off	Wi-Fi networking disabled or system connected to Ethernet

Disabling Wi-Fi[®] capability

The SoundTouch $^{\scriptscriptstyle \rm M}$ wireless adapter has built-in Wi-Fi capability that enables wireless connectivity.

- 1. Power on your CineMate[®] 120, 130, 220, or 520 system.
- 2. Press and hold the adapter's Control button (8 10 seconds).
- 3. When the Wi-Fi indicator turns off, release the Control button.

Re-enabling Wi-Fi® capability

Power on your CineMate® 120, 130, 220, or 520 system.

You can mount the wireless adapter on a wall (hardware not included). If your mounting hardware comes with instructions that differ from these instructions, follow the instructions supplied with your hardware.

This table describes mounting hardware specifications.

Mounting the adapter

There are two ways to mount the adapter:

- Vertically; connector panel facing left.
- Horizontally; connector panel facing up.

To mount the adapter

1. Drill two holes 6 ¼ in. (159 mm) center-to-center.



- 2. Insert plastic wall anchors (if mounting to wallboard).
- 3. Install pan-head wood screws.

Note: Leave the screw heads 1/4 in. (6.35 mm) above wall surface.

4. Position the adapter onto the screws and press firmly into place.

Troubleshooting

Problem	What to do
Cannot complete network setup	 Plug the SoundTouch[™] wireless adapter into the Bose[®] link connector and power on the system. Connect the system to AC (mains) power. Select correct network name and enter password. Connect the device and SoundTouch[™] system to the same Wi-Fi[®] network. Place the wireless adapter within range of the router. Enable Wi-Fi on the device (mobile or computer) you are using for setup. If network name does not appear or is hidden, select Manually Connect to Another Network on the CONNECT TO HOME WI-FI NETWORK screen. Close other open applications. If using a computer for setup, check firewall settings to ensure that the SoundTouch[™] app and SoundTouch[™] Music Server are allowed programs. Test your Internet connection by loading www.SoundTouch.com Restart your mobile device, or computer, and router. Uninstall the app, reset the system, and restart setup.
Cannot connect to network	 If your network has changed or to connect your system to another network, refer to the Help system in the app. Connect to the network using an Ethernet cable.
Interference	Keep the SoundTouch [™] wireless adapter away from the Acoustimass [®] module, console, metal objects, other audio/video components, and direct heat sources.

Resetting the SoundTouch[™] wireless adapter

Reset the SoundTouch[™] wireless adapter to clear all SoundTouch[™] source information and network credentials from the system and return it to original factory settings.

Note: This reset function erases your SoundTouch[™] Presets and saved network credentials.

- 1. Power on your CineMate[®] 120, 130, 220, or 520 system.
- 2. Unplug the Bose[®] link cable.
- **3.** Press and hold the control button (8 10 seconds) while reconnecting the cable.

Cleaning

To clean the SoundTouch[™] wireless adapter, wipe the enclosure using a soft, dry cloth.

- Do not use solvents, chemicals, or sprays.
- Do not allow liquids to spill or objects to drop into any openings.

Important setup information

* The SETUP A USB connector on the back of the system is for computer setup only. The USB connectors are not designed to charge smartphones, tablets, or similar devices.

Using a desktop computer for setup

If you are using a desktop computer, move the console and SoundTouch[™] wireless adapter near the computer to set up your system. During setup, the app prompts you to connect the USB cable from the computer to the wireless adapter (temporarily).

After setup, disconnect the USB cable and the console from your computer and from AC (mains power) and move the system to its permanent location.
